



Codorus TRICK OR TREAT 2024 SITE AGREEMENT

- This agreement is between the Friends of Codorus State Park (FOCSP) and campers and businesses participating in the Codorus Trick or Treat (CTOT) fundraiser. CTOT will be held on Friday, October 25 and Saturday, October 26, 2024 at the Codorus State Park. **Contact person: Kathy Bealing, (717) 476-1630, codorustreats@gmail.com.**

1. SITE FEE COSTS - ALL SITE FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE

- CAMPSITES
 - \$75 -Electric
 - \$60 - Non-Electric
 - \$95 - Full Hook-Up
- BUSINESS SITES
 - \$75 for a 12' X 12' display area. (Location will be confirmed one week prior to the event or sooner.)

2. CHECK-IN / CHECK-OUT

- Check-in: 9:00 am, Thursday, October 24, 2024
- Check-out: 5:00 pm, Sunday, October 27, 2024
- When you arrive, there is no need to check in at the Contact (Ranger) Station; just proceed to your site.
- Be sure you have your PASS displayed on your vehicle dashboard while at the campground. Passes will be emailed the week before the event.

3. DECORATIONS

- **Family-friendly** Halloween or Fall theme, no "blood and guts," dismembered body parts, etc. No jumping out or creeping up closely to visitors. Respect their space. (FOCSP may refuse any part of a display.)
- Run a string of lights along the road at your site to keep it well lit.
- Do not cover the site numbers on the post at your site. It's easier for visitors to reference where they are if they get lost. If you can light up the number, all the better.
- Keep decorations on until 10:00 pm each night.

4. DISTRIBUTE CANDY/TREATS

- **Pass out candy/treats between 6:30 pm - 9:00 pm on BOTH Friday and Saturday nights.** If something comes up and this is not possible, please contact Kathy 717-476-1630.
- Plan for 3,000 pieces for the weekend or more. Be sure candy is individually wrapped. One piece per child is fine!
- Business sites may hand out business literature along with a treat but no sales, please.

5. ONLY ONE CAMPER/RV PER SITE or no more than 2 large tents per site. One tent is also permitted if you have a camper or RV.

6. NO VEHICULAR MOVEMENT IN C & D LOOPS FROM 6:00 PM TO 9:30 PM ON BOTH NIGHTS. Also, traffic will be stopped for the Pet Parade on Saturday from 11 am to noon, or until the last entrant finishes the loop.

- *THIS IS FOR THE SAFETY OF THE CHILDREN AND WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.*
- *The road will be barricaded during these hours. If you have an emergency and must leave, call 717-476-1630 for an escort! Non-compliance may forfeit your invitation to return. **Be sure to tell everyone at your site!***

7. VEHICLE PARKING - NO PARKING PERMITTED ON THE GRASS OR ALONG THE ROAD!

Parking is an ongoing challenging issue with this event! PLEASE, CARPOOL, CARPOOL, CARPOOL!

If you have handicap parking needs for yourself or visitors, call Kathy at 717-476-1630 for special designated area.

Be sure the pass is displayed on the vehicle's dashboard!

a. CAMPER PARKING:

- You may have one car at your site on the parking pad only, as per park rules.
- Extra vehicles must be parked at the "Off Site Parking Areas" listed below.
- We encourage campers to move the one vehicle your normally keep at your site to the Amphitheater parking during the trick or treat hours to make it easier to pass out candy. Do this early before the lot fills which is around 4 pm.
- If you have a trailer that needs parked off your site, call Kathy 717-476-1630 for special designated area.

b. CAMPER'S VISITOR PARKING:

- Please purchase a ticket and use the event parking lots to ensure that participating campers and business staff have priority parking in the campground. Gates open at 3 pm.
- If arriving before 3 pm, park at "Off Site Parking Areas" only.

c. BUSINESS STAFF PARKING:

- No parking is permitted at the 12x12 areas. All staff is to carpool! Arrive before 4 pm and park in the Amphitheater parking lot.

d. OFF-SITE PARKING AREAS

- Amphitheater Lot (by the playground) - This is the best place to park if you need to enter or leave while the road is barricaded from 6 pm - 9:30 pm, Friday and Saturday.
- Lower end of D loop
- D loop bathhouse, not on the grass
- Timberdoodle campsites on the parking pads only, not on the grass. (This area may be barricaded to prevent boats from using the launch. If needed, call Kathy about parking status there: 717-476-1630.)
- Parking lot by the Contact (Ranger) Station at the campground entrance.

8. PETS - NO MORE THAN 2 DOGS PER SITE

- Confine all dogs inside camper, or behind tent(s) and/or canopies during trick or treat hours.
- **KEEP DOGS LEASHED AT ALL TIMES, NO EXCEPTIONS** and cleaned up after them.
- Keep dogs quiet during quiet hours: Thursday night after 9 pm, Friday and Saturday, after 9:30 pm.

9. CLEAN UP CAMPSITE

- Dispose of trash in the dumpsters in the campground at either bath house.
- Check your site and roadway for candy wrappers, etc.
- Lost items can be brought to the Information Station - Site #122 (yurt).
- If you lost an item, you can check at Site #122 or the park office. Office phone: 717-637-2816.

10. CAMPFIRES AND CAMPING SUPPLIES.

- Safely monitor campfires at all times.
- Firewood, ice and other camp supplies are available at the Outpost Camp Store located near the Contact (Ranger) Station near the campground entrance. Hours of operation will be posted there.

11. DIAL 911 IN CASE OF EMERGENCY.

- If you have a medical emergency, dial 911. Emergency staff is on site during the event.
