## Quick Reference to Make Your Reservation

- Check your email on April 15 for the reservation link.
- You will automatically receive a receipt for your payment at the email you provided with your payment.
- Save a copy of that receipt as proof of your reservation.
- Download the pdf of the CTOT Site Agreement from the website.
- Deadline for reservations is June 1, 2024.
- Tell any family or friends wishing to get a site this year to call Kathy at 717-476-1630 on June 15 at 9 am SHARP. *(If I don't answer, leave a message and I'll get back to everyone in the order that they called.)*

## Tips if You Want to Change Your Site

1. Reserve the site you had in 2023 as quickly as possible... AND
2. Be sure to type "yes" plus any site preference you have in the designated field, "Do you want to change your site?" on the reservation form.
3. The longer you wait to submit your reservation, the fewer choices you'll have since it's first come, first served for site changes.
4. Kathy will call those who requested a site change after June 1 with site availability. You can decide then whether you'd like to change your site or stay where you are. If the site change is an upgrade from what you had in 2023, you will need to pay the additional amount at that time using any major credit card.
5. Preferential treatment is given to 2023 campers, but only before the June 1 deadline. After the deadline, not only do you lose your 2023 site, but then you must take your chances on what is left if you still want a site, by calling on June 15 when sites open to the public.
